The session will include a practical group exercise on scoping researchers' data management support needs.</p>
14:00-15:00	<p>Ethical and legal aspects of managing and sharing research data, Veerle Van den Eynden, UK Data Archive</p> <p>This session will introduce participants to issues that need to be addressed, often early on in research, when planning to share or archive data for longer term curation and preservation. Particular emphasis will be placed on ethical and legal aspects of data sharing, handling and sharing confidential information and personal data, informed consent and data sharing and data anonymisation; especially where research involves people as participants. The session will include a practical group exercise based on the UK Data Archive's guidance.</p>
