History

- DCC checklist for data management plans 2008
- DMPonline V1 launched April 2010 focus on UK but included other models (e.g. NSF requirements)
 from outset
- DMPTool work begins in 2011, led by UC3 collaboration between them and DCC from the outset
- ADMP interest group discussions at RDA P3 (Dublin) 2014 established 2016
- February 2016 DMPTool & DMPonline agree to establish a single codebase DMPRoadmap is born!
 - At about the same time U Alberta establishes DMP Assistant using DMPonline code with support from DCC – becomes part of Portage, then Alliance national service in Canada
- RDA P9 (2017) ADMP IG session establishes 3 working groups, including maDMPs
- January 2018 live services now all using the DMPRoadmap codebase





The codebase and the services

- Our codebase DMPRoadmap is shared
- Our services behave differently
- DMPTool a collaboration of US universities
- DMPonline subscription service to institutions, funders, national bodies (but free to use for any researcher)
- DMP Assistant a funded national service for Canada
- DMP OPIDoR a portal for data management for HEIs in France
- The names in each case characterise the service provided by each deployment
